


HEREFORDSHIRE VIRTUAL SCHOOL GAMES BALANCE CHALLENGE!

THE CHALLENGE

Measure a 10m distance using two markers.

Balancing a ball on a bat, see how many shuttles you can complete in 30 seconds. If you drop the object you must pick it up and rebalance it before you start to move again.



EQUIPMENT

Try and use a tennis racquet / cricket bat / table tennis paddle and balance a ball on this item.

ADAPTATIONS

Use a bigger bat and ball or balance a balloon on your hand. Use a boiled egg and spoon or a book and a piece of fruit.

SCORING

You score 1 point for each shuttle you complete.




HEREFORDSHIRE VIRTUAL SCHOOL GAMES TARGET CHALLENGE!

THE CHALLENGE

Throw an object into the target area from 3m (primary) or 5m (high) away. You have 60 seconds.

You must collect your object yourself and go back to your throwing line before you make another attempt.



EQUIPMENT

Use a netball or basketball ring and one ball to score as many goals/baskets as possible in the time.

ADAPTATIONS

If throwing is too difficult, mark an area out on the floor and roll a ball into a marked area.

Use a scrunched up piece of paper and a bin

Scoring

You score one point for each successful throw or roll.




HEREFORDSHIRE VIRTUAL SCHOOL GAMES CATCH AND PASS CHALLENGE!

THE CHALLENGE

With a partner pass a ball back and forth as many times as you can in 60 seconds

Primary stand 5m away high stand 7m away



EQUIPMENT

Use a basketball, netball, tennis/cricket ball.

ADAPTATIONS

Use a balloon and stand closer to your partner.

Use any ball or a small cushion if you don't have a ball.

You score a point for each successful catch you and your partner make.






HEREFORDSHIRE VIRTUAL SCHOOL GAMES RUMMING CHALLENGE!
