STRIDE ACTIVE PARTNERSHIP

The new Partnership covers everything you need to stay up-to-date, access CPD and support, whilst ensuring your pupils can access interventions and activities that meet their needs. It's all the important things rolled into one.

Termly meetings include updates on local, regional and national agenda items, as well as receiving support, advice and new ideas! Each meeting will also include practical CPD; this is an opportunity to increase your skills and knowledge which you can take back to your school. Partnership schools will be able to bring 2 members of staff to each meeting.



COMPETITIONS

We know that taking part in competitions and festivals can be a really positive experience young people.

It allows them to compete and represent their school, whilst contributing to their social development and enabling them to develop teamwork skills, communication and respect for others.

As the focus of the School Games continues to be placed on targeted groups of pupils, Stride Active competitions will provide opportunities for localised competitions, open to any young person. This will ensure that a greater number of young people can represent their school in sport. The competitions will focus on teamwork, enjoyment and other sporting values, designed to suit the needs of your area.

COMPETITION DETAILS

- **All-year round competitions**
- **5 inter-school competitions per area**
- **1 netball league per area, with county final**
- **Opportunities for A, B & C teams**
- **Areas will be able to tailor the sports, age groups and type of competition**
- **Priority access to a summer festival**

Competitions will take place throughout the school year.

There will be competitions in the north, city and south areas of Herefordshire (minimum number required). Schools will decide on the competitions in their areas at the start of the academic year and whether they would prefer them to be competitive or participation based. .

Sport options may include: Tag Rugby, Netball, Basketball, Tennis, Girls Football, Hockey, Rounders, Dodgeball, Bowls, Sportshall Athletics, & Multiskills festivals.

BESPOKE SUPPORT

We will also continue to offer bespoke to schools. Support may include:

- Developing a vision for PE and /or wellbeing
- Curriculum mapping and planning
- Observing PE lessons to up-skill the PE Co-ordinator
- Mock 'deep dive' into PE
- Staff CPD on differentiation, assessment and quality lessons, or activity-specific, such as gymnastics
- Young leader training and development
- 1:1 teacher support to develop skills and confidence
- Training for support staff
- In-house competitions
